Introduction to GIS 2 Introduction Definition of GIS Like the field of geography, the term Geographic Information System (GIS) is hard to define It represents the integration of many subject areas Accordingly there us no absolutely agreed upon definition of a GIS (deMers, 1997) A broadly accepted definition of GIS is the one provided by the
